Duties and Responsibilities

- Reports to the Executive Director
- Collaborate with club coaches to provide developmental opportunities (Technical and Sport Science) for Developmental Program, Canadian Competitive Program, High Performance Program.
- Allocated % of time to be spent between various levels:
 - Developmental Program Levels 1-4 – 20%
 - Canadian Competitive Program Levels 5-7 – 20%
 - Canadian Competitive Program Levels 8-10, Aspire and High Performance – 50%
 - Up to discretion of Executive Director – 10%
- Collaborate with club coaches to provide developmental opportunities for Provincial, National and High-Performance Coaches.
- Liaise with Sport Manitoba Performance Centre and Canadian Sport Centre of Manitoba where applicable to provide opportunities for Coaches and Athletes
- Must attend Developmental Program Assembly and Women's Technical Committee Meetings
- Schedule developmental opportunities and assist in lining up facilitators where required in collaboration with Executive Director
- Provide an annual written report on program results, activities, and coach development opportunities.

Qualifications

- Applicant must be a Minimum of Competition Development Certified.
- Applicant must complete a Child Abuse Registry Check annually as paid for by the Association.
- Applicant must complete a Criminal Record Check annually as paid for by the Association.
- Applicant must be Respect in Sport certified and complete its renewal every 5 years.
- Applicant must be available ~15 hours per week
- Applicant must have a minimum of 5 years coaching experience.
- Must possess:
 - Strong written and verbal communication skills
 - Leadership skills
 - Ability to manage conflict
 - Adapt to change
 - Willingness to continually develop their own technical skills
 - Understanding of the Technical Structure of MGA programs and committees
- Preference will be given to independent (non-club affiliated) applicants.
