JUDGES	Each province is asked to send their highest certified or experienced judges whenever possible. If a province is unable to meet their quota, they are to contact the LOC who will determine if they are able to meet the requirements with judges from the host province. Failure to provide sufficient judges, or have those judges named not show up, shall result in a \$500 fine per missing judge which will be levied against the province. Allocation for the 2025 event will be sent to the PSO and/or their respective judging chairs.
