ATTIRE	All competitors and coaches must dress in competition attire on the competition floor.

ATHELTE COMPETITION ATTIRE	All GymCan rules apply for proper attire for specific and general warm-up and competition. Athletes may wear either male or female TEAM uniform.
TEAM FINALS THEME	<p>Team Finals will be “Safari Theme”! Coaches, judges, parents, and athletes may participate, but please remember that proper attire MUST be worn for competition!</p> 
JUDGES	Each province is asked to send their highest certified or experienced judges whenever possible. If a province is unable to meet their quota, they are to contact the LOC who will determine if they are able to meet the requirements with judges from the host province. Failure to provide sufficient judges, or have those judges named not show up, shall result in a \$500 fine per missing judge which will be levied against the province. Allocation for the 2025 event has been sent to the PSO and/or their respective judging chairs.
